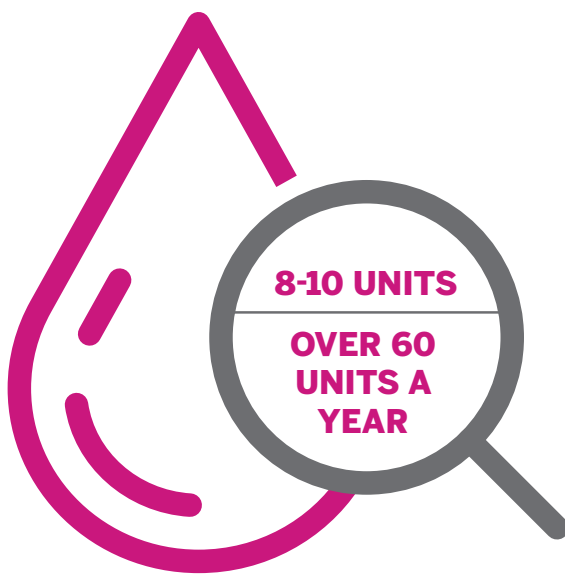


Why is **R₀ blood** important and who needs it?

As an R₀ donor, you have the power to save the lives of patients in your community, **ESPECIALLY INDIVIDUALS BATTLING SICKLE CELL DISEASE** who require more extensively matched blood.

So, if one of these patients has the R₀ blood type, usually they need blood of an R₀ donor.



8-10 units are needed for an adult patient for one transfusion exchange – that's over 60 units of blood/year for therapy

At least **20 R₀ donors** are needed to support that single patient
